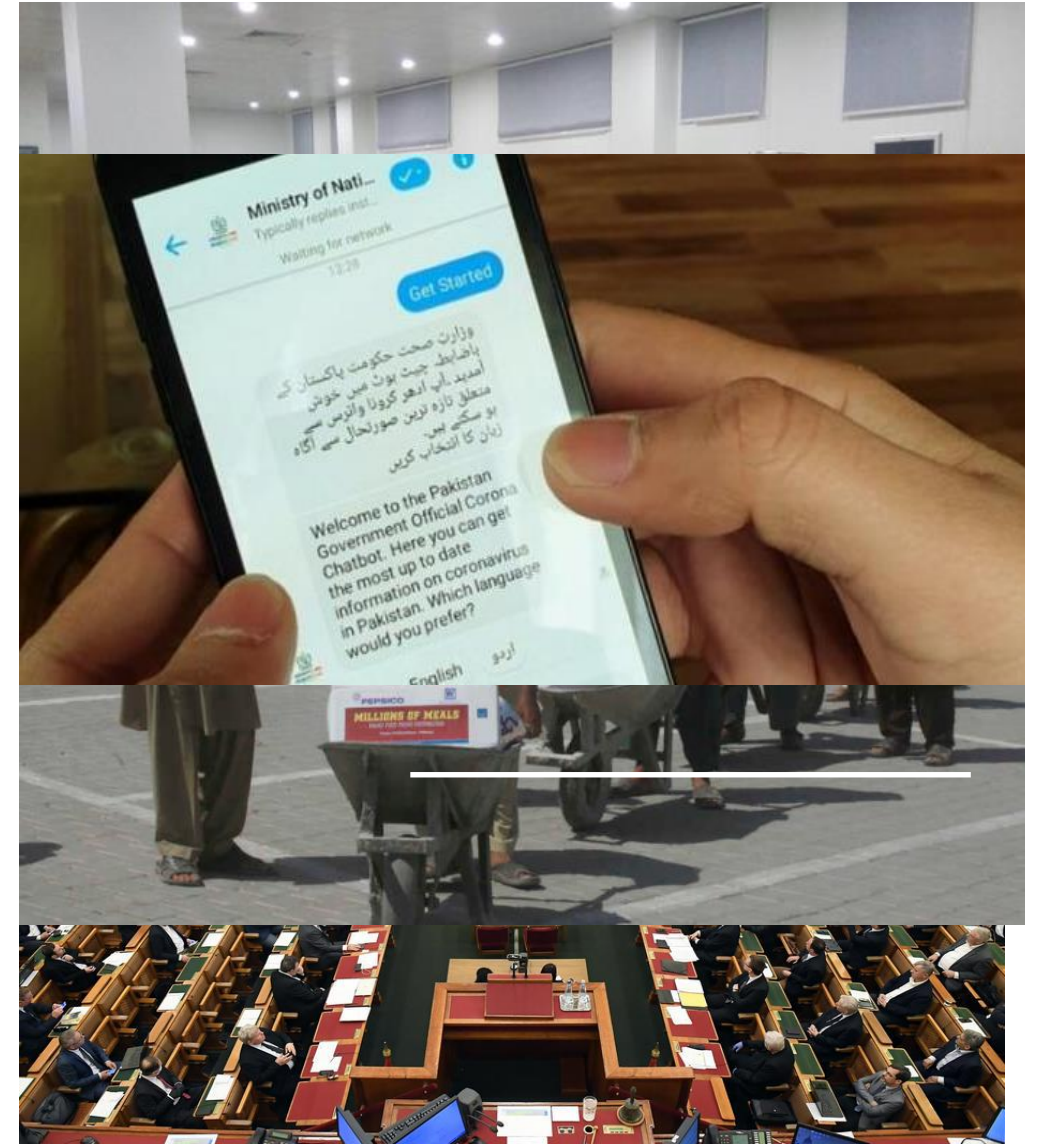

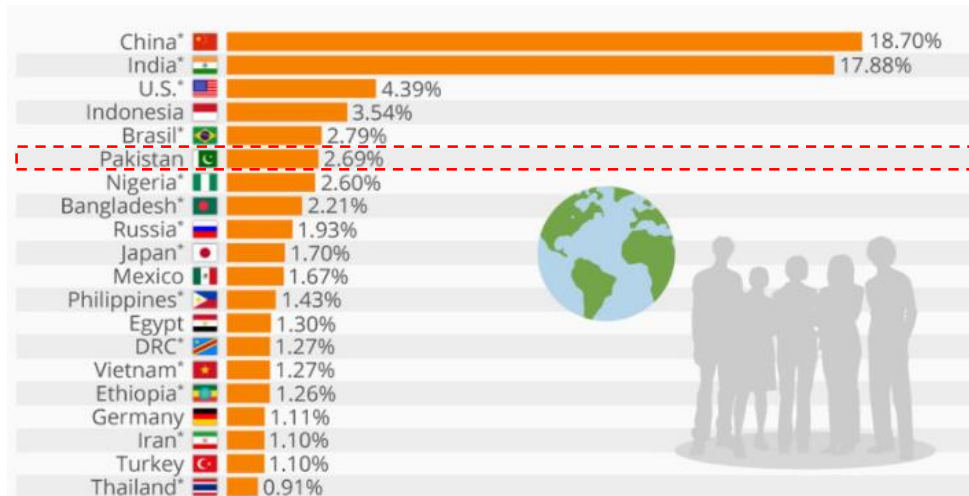

Ranking – Population



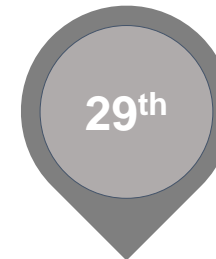
Pakistan is ranked 6th in the world ranking in terms of population
