

## Documentation Checklist for Members of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Pakistan

## Key features for members in good standing seeking the Canadian CPA designation:

- Receive exemption from all prerequisites for admission to the PEP and from all PEP education modules.
- To prepare for success on the CFE, ICAP members are strongly recommended to complete Capstone 1 and Capstone 2, and gain core knowledge of:
  - o Canadian tax
  - Canadian law

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- o Canadian Accounting Standards for Private Entities
- Must successfully complete the Common Final Examination
- Are deemed to meet Canadian CPA experience requirements for certification if they have completed:
  - o Two years of post-designation experience plus a recognized university degree, or
  - Five years of post-designation experience but no recognized university degree

The MOU applies to certification only. Public practice rights are determined by the provincial CPA body.

All other applicants must have a minimum of five years post-certification experience. Applicants with less than the specified post-qualification experience will be subject to a review of their practical experience obtained pre- and post- qualification. All experience must have been gained as a member of the ICAP.
