



BSc (Hons) Professional Accounting Top-up

This programme enhances the knowledge gained through professional studies by the development of analytical and problem- solving skills, critical thinking and social responsibility in a professional accounting context. It is a research driven programme focusing on contemporary issues in accounting and their implications for organizational performance.

The programme will enable partially qualified accountants of **ICAP** to obtain an Honours degree by completing 120 credits of Level 6 study that extends their professional studies with coverage of analytical skills, problem- solving, critical thinking and social responsibility in a professional accounting context.

If you have completed CA's Assessment of Fundamental Competencies (AFC) to Certificate in Accounting and Finance (CAF) OR Certified Finance and Accounting Professional (CFAP) you will be considered for entry onto this course.

1. Tuition fees:

BSc (Hons) Professional Accounting Top-up - £5,060

2. Payment details:

25% of tuition fee to be paid prior to enrolment, remaining fee can be paid in instalments upon agreement with Finance.

3. Course start dates:

BSc (Hons) Professional Accounting Top-Up: 30th September 2024

4. Entry requirements:

Students who have satisfactorily completed AFC 1-4 and CAF 1-9 with ICAP are eligible to apply for direct entry to BSc Professional Accounting Top-Up at the University of Northampton

The number of students on the programme is restricted to 50 candidates in each session. Please be advised that we will have two cohorts per year - September and January intake

6. Documents required:

Certificates and transcripts of ICAP modules completed to-date. If your certifications are awarded prior to 2015 you will need to provide a letter of equivalence from ICAP. <https://www.icap.org.pk/students/examination/verification-letters-attestation-doc/>

- Copy of passport including signature page. Passport must be valid at the time of application.
- Current detailed CV stating start and finish dates of all education and work experience to date. Please include detailed explanation of job responsibilities undertaken in each role.
