1. Tuition fees: MSc Accounting and Finance Top-Up - £2,355

2. Payment details:

25% of tuition fee to be paid prior to enrolment, remaining fee can be paid in installments upon agreement with Finance.

- Course start dates: MSc Accounting and Finance Top-Up: 27th Jan 2024 & 30th Sep 2024
- 4. Entry requirements:

Students who have satisfactorily completed CFAP 1-6 and MSA 1-2 with ICAP are eligible to apply for direct entry to MSc Accounting & Finance Top-Up at the University of Northampton.

5. Application submission:

6. Documents required:

Certificates and transcripts of ICAP modules completed to-date. If your certifications are awarded prior to 2015 you will need to provide a letter of equivalence from ICAP. https://www.icap.org.pk/students/examination/verification-letters-attestation-doc/

- Copy of English language certificate. You will need to achieve IELTS 6.5 overall with no less than 5.5 in any band
- Copy of passport including signature page. Passport must be valid at the time of application.
- Current detailed CV stating start and finish dates of all education and work experience to date. Please include detailed explanation of job responsibilities undertaken in each role.

Note:

Top-Up course options are being offered by distance learning only. Entry is not guaranteed and subject to standard University entry requirements.

The above module mapping is based on the most recent ICAP curriculum dated 2015. ICAP members who have completed their qualification prior to 2015 and have different module codes and titles will need to provide a letter from ICAP stating that their courses are equivalent of AFC/CAF/CFAP/MSA
